To apply for child care assistance, parents should contact the county Department of Human Services for the county that they live in. Everyone must fill out an application and provide information about their income and work or school program.

Family Size and Income Guidelines to Qualify

You are within the required guidelines to receive child care subsidies if your family's total monthly gross income is within the maximum defined below:

To Calculate Income:

$$\text{Weekly Gross Income} \times 4.33 = \text{Total Monthly Gross}$$
